What are some of the goals of HHSAF?


*Assisting graduating Hicksville High School Seniors in achieving their dreams and career goals through the awarding of scholarships to college and trade schools.


*Raising funds to support the needs of Hicksville High School clubs and district-wide programs which can't be funded by limited tax levied money


